after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, changed, substituted, corrected, completed, or signed and no entry fees refunded. Telephoned or FAX entries are not accepted, except through the services listed below. All changes or cancellations must be made in writing and received prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6, of the American Kennel Club Dog Show Rules. Telephone changes or cancellations are NOT acceptable.

ALL ENTRY FORMS must be signed, and photocopies must include the back with the agreement, otherwise the entry cannot be accepted and will be returned.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS on entry blanks, and for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors.

ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED (except bitches in season) in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the show committee. If because of weather, riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee(s) will be made.

BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT PERMITTED TO COMPETE in obedience or rally trials. The Obedience Club of San Diego County, Inc., will refund all but whatever is necessary to cover the AKC entry fees for bitches unable to compete for this reason. Request for refund must be given to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging or by letter postmarked not later than the day before the opening of the trial.

MOVE-UPS After a dog earns a title, it may be moved up to the next class in a future trial even though the closing date for the trial has passed.

This move-up may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. The request for a move-up must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Move-ups may be approved, provided the next level class (i.e., Novice to Open) and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The club and/or its Trial Secretary will not be responsible for, and are not obligated to furnish any service for, notifying exhibitors or their agents of Class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or their handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED OR SHOWN UNDER A JUDGE AT AN OBEDIENCE OR RALLY TRIAL if the dog has been owned, sold, held under lease, handled in the ring, or has been regularly trained or instructed within one year prior to the date of the obedience or rally trial by the judge or by any person residing in the same household as the judge.

THE TRIAL-GIVING CLUB, THE TRIAL SECRETARY, their agents or employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of their parents or guardians.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Club and/or its Show Secretary will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis for future events of the Club. The returned check MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog(s) will be allowed in the ring.

DECLINATION OF ENTRIES: The club may decline any entry for cause and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately after unless required for further judging.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: Please make every effort to clean up your area, either on the show grounds or in the parking area. Because of the carelessness of some exhibitors, show sites are becoming more difficult to obtain. The Obedience Club of San Diego County, Inc., asks your cooperation in cleaning up after yourself and your dogs. By signing the entry form at this show you are agreeing that all clean-up for your dogs is your responsibility.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

FOOD AND SNACKS

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the CLUB will NOT be providing any food or refreshments to exhibitors.

SPECIAL COVID-19 TRIAL GUIDELINES

These trials will not be operating "business as usual." Hosting a trial and exhibiting is a privilege. It will be up to all of us to do our best and do it right!

We will be adhering to State of California, County of San Diego, and City of Escondido public health regulations in addition to CDC and AKC guidelines. Our aim is to keep our judges, volunteers and exhibitors as safe as possible.

GENERAL PRACTICES – Clubs, officials & participants are required to follow state, local & facility guidelines that apply to the area & site where the event is held. Exhibitors should wash hands as frequently as possible. Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility. Avoid common use pens/pencils – bring your own. Exhibitors must provide their own scoops for cleaning up from their dogs in and around showgrounds. Prepare to be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer, bring personal use masks. Know the armband numbers for your entries before going to the ring. Do not congregate at the ring or ring gate.

1. **If you feel unwell**, have a fever, cough, sneezing, sore throat, (or any others symptoms that have been associated with COVID-19), please stay home.
2. **EXPOSURE TO COVID-19** If within 14 days prior to the trials you have been in the presence of a person who has either tested positive for COVID-19 or has the symptoms noted above, please stay home.
3. **Physical Distancing:** Maintain at least six feet between you and other exhibitors or spectators at all times. Avoid congregating to the extent possible. Avoid physical contact, (shaking hands or hugging). Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
4. **Face Masks:** Correctly positioned face masks that cover the nose and mouth are required at all times on and around the show grounds, (including parking area). The show committee plans on allowing exhibitors to lower their face mask while in the ring exhibiting. Anyone lowering their face mask while in the ring must correctly reposition their mask before exiting the ring. Please note that additional public health orders put in place on or before the day of our trial may not allow this. Further, the judge may not allow this. Anyone attending this trial who refuses to wear a mask on or around the show grounds, (including parking area), will be required to leave and entries will be forfeited. *Exhibitors must supply their own masks!*
5. **Parking:** Park with increased distance between vehicles wherever possible. This is especially critical if handlers are crating from their vehicles. Masks required in Parking Area.
6. **Show and go:** Please do not remain on showgrounds any longer than necessary. You and your dog should only be on the grounds to; acclimate, warm-up, walk course (if applicable), exhibit, collect ribbons/prizes. Once your event(s) have concluded, please leave showgrounds.
7. **Crating/Shade:** If entered in only one class, please crate from your vehicle if practical to do so. If you do crate from your vehicle, please be cognizant of weather conditions (heat), bring adequate shade for your vehicle or consider leaving vehicle running with air conditioning on, etc. If entered in multiple classes and plan on bringing canopy onto showgrounds for shade, please maintain at least six feet of separation between your canopy and any neighboring canopies. Do not share canopy with anyone that is not from your immediate household. If you are asked to move farther away – PLEASE DO IT.
8. **Check-In** without your dog. If there is a line, maintain at least six feet between you and the next person.
9. **Prizes:** At the conclusion of each class, judge will call qualifiers into the ring.
 - a. Maintain a minimum of six feet between you and other individuals in the ring. Your dog need not be present for this ceremony and if possible please leave dog crated.
 - b. Ribbons and prizes will be available at a designated location away from the ring.
10. **Spectators:** To minimize the number of people on the showgrounds, spectators are not recommended – this includes spouses or significant others. Only handlers and their dogs should come to the trial.
11. **Judges and stewards** will maintain social distance as practical in and around the ring between each other, exhibitors and spectators. Hand sanitizer or washing supplies will be available at ring(s). Gloves will also be provided to judges, stewards and show committee members who wish to have another layer of protection. Avoid shared use of pens/pencils.
12. **Lunch will be on your own for all exhibitors.** Individually packaged lunch and water will be available for judges, stewards and committee members only.
13. **Video Recording:** Please do not handle someone else's phone to video a performance. Consider recording using your own device and transfer video electronically.

Any person who fails to follow these guidelines at all times during these events or on the showgrounds during show hours will be investigated by the trial committee for misconduct prejudicial to the interests of the sport and may result in expulsion from this event and possible sanction by AKC.

- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
